# Get started in 4 steps

#### STEP 1


# Get a prompt via email or text

### 01. Use any device

We'll send a weekly prompt via email or text message. You can use Remento on any device, like a smartphone, tablet, or computer.

### 02. Answer each week

Your prompts will arrive each week, but you can decide when you answer. The message we send will link directly to Remento's recording website.



# Record your memory

### 01. Access recording website

Open Remento by clicking on the link in the email or text message we sent you.

## 02. Pick video or audio-only


Select whether you're comfortable recording a video or prefer audio only and allow permissions on your device.

## 03. Record your memory

Press the big green button and answer the question on the screen. You can pause and resume recording anytime.

# 04. Submit your story

Follow the steps to submit your story. Wait for your story to upload, and then choose to record another story or wait for next week's prompt.



# Tips for telling a great story

#### **FIND A QUIET PLACE**

Record your stories in a distraction-free space with clear audio for your microphone.

#### **SHARE CONTEXT**

Use background information to set the scene – how old were you, who was there?

#### **USE ALL YOUR SENSES**

Transport listeners by describing the smells, textures, and sounds you remember.

#### **GET SPECIFIC**

Add richness by sharing more than generalities. Even if you have to pause to think through the details, take the time to include them.

#### SHOW HOW THE MEMORIES FEEL

Evoke emotions – rather than saying "I was excited," talk about the butterflies you felt and how you couldn't stop smiling.


# Read and edit your story

When you finish recording a memory, Remento gets to work turning your voice into a written story. But that's just the start - you can edit the automatically generated story title and text at any point.

# 01. Pick default writing style

Our Writing Assistant crafts a written story in either the first or third person (default), or maintains the exact words and structure with a "cleaned transcript." The settings can be changed in your "project settings" at any time.






### 02. Edit words or details

Once the recording has uploaded, you can select to edit and change any words, add text, or remove text. You have full control of how your story is written.

# 03. Edit your story title

Along with crafting the body of the story, Remento will also generate a title. You can change this title anytime by tapping "Edit story."



# Receive your book

Once you're ready, it's time to get your book printed. You can customize your book's cover, choose the sequence of your stories, and order your book to be shipped. Plus, you can order additional copies too.

# Have photos to add to your book?

If you have great photos that bring memories of your past to life, there are two ways to incorporate them into your Remento Book.

# Create a photo prompt

Either add a photo to a new prompt in Remento, or send pictures to a family member so they can add it for you.

# Or add a photo after recording

If you don't have the photo uploaded before you tell the story, you can still record your memory and upload the photo later (anytime before you print your book).
